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Safety Warning

Important Safety Instructions

- Please read carefully and keep for future reference.
- During use, ensure that the power plug of the household appliance is fully inserted into the power outlet and maintains good contact.
- When an extension cord power outlet is required, use one that meets national standards.
- When personnel leave the area, please disconnect the power.
- If the product produces abnormal noise, odor, high temperature, or malfunctions, immediately stop using it, turn off the switch, and disconnect the power.
- ⚠ Warning: Power should not be supplied to household appliances from a lamp head with a socket.
- ⚠ Warning: The total rated current of household appliances connected to the extension cord power outlet should not exceed the rated current of the original fixed outlet or circuit.
- ⚠ Warning: This product should not be used near flammable or explosive materials or in similar environments.
- ⚠ Warning: Users should not disassemble household appliances themselves and should not modify internal wiring, components, and protective devices.
- ⚠ Warning: When removing the plug from the outlet, do not pull on the power cord.
- ⚠ Warning: Users should not replace the fuses in household appliances and power supplies with ordinary conductors or fuses exceeding the specified current capacity.
- ⚠ Warning: Users should not alter the settings of low-voltage circuit breakers or
- Precautions must be taken during the user's maintenance and care:
 - ✘ Clean the product after it has cooled.
The microwave oven should be cleaned regularly and all food residues removed. Not cleaning the microwave oven can lead to surface degradation of the appliance, affecting its lifespan and potentially causing hazardous situations.
 - ✘ The product's exterior can be wiped with a cloth dampened with a mild detergent (such as dish soap), then wiped clean with a damp cloth, and finally dried with a dry cloth. Never use steel brushes or other hard objects to clean the product. Do not clean the oven door safety lock system.
 - ✘ Keep the bottom of the oven cavity clean to avoid abnormal noise caused by the turntable during operation of the microwave oven.
 - ✘ The product has two types of waveguiding: side waveguiding and top waveguiding. For products with side waveguiding, there is a waveguide port on the right side of the cavity. Keep the waveguide port clean and do not remove the waveguide cover (mica sheet) to prevent arcing
 - ✘ Clean the door seal, cavity, and details of adjacent components; If the product has not been used for a long time, use the grilling function for a few minutes before use to evaporate any accumulated moisture inside the product. (Actual product features apply)
 - ✘ Keep the oven cavity bottom clean to avoid abnormal noise from the turntable during operation.

- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with physical, sensory, or mental disabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, including children, unless they have been supervised or instructed by a person responsible for their safety concerning the use of the appliance
 - Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with this appliance.
 - This appliance can be used at altitudes up to 4000 meters.
 - This appliance contains a grounding connection which is used only for functional purposes. (Actual product features may vary)
 - If the power cord is damaged, to avoid danger, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agency, or similarly qualified persons.
- ⚠ Warning: If the microwave oven door or door seal is damaged, do not use it until it has been repaired by a qualified service person.
- ⚠ Warning: Maintenance operations other than those described in the user manual are to be performed only by qualified service personnel, including the replacement of the cover designed to prevent microwave leakage, which can be dangerous.
- ⚠ Warning: Do not heat liquids or other foods in sealed containers, as this could cause an explosion.
- The appliance is intended for household and similar use, such as:
 - ✖ In staff kitchens in shops, offices, and other working environments;
 - ✖ Farms;
 - ✖ Hotels, motels, and other residential environments used by customers;
 - ✖ Budget hotels providing only bed and breakfast.
 - The minimum height required for free space above the top casing of the microwave oven.
 - Use only vessels suitable for use in the microwave oven.
 - Do not use metal containers when cooking food and beverages in the microwave oven. This requirement does not apply if the manufacturer specifies the dimensions and shape of metal containers suitable for microwave cooking.
 - When heating food in plastic or paper containers, monitor the microwave oven to prevent the possibility of a fire.
 - Use the microwave oven to heat food and beverages. Drying food or clothing, and heating warm pads, slippers, sponges, wet cloths, and similar items can pose a risk of injury, fire, or deflagration.
 - Be cautious of smoke.
If smoke is detected, turn off the appliance or unplug the power plug, and keep the oven door closed to suppress the spread of flames.
 - Microwaving beverages can cause delayed splattering and boiling, so handle with care when removing or placing them.
 - Food in baby bottles and baby food jars should be stirred or shaken, and the temperature of the food in the bottle should be checked before feeding to avoid burns.
 - Do not use the microwave oven to heat whole eggs in the shell or whole eggs that have already been cooked, as they may explode during or even after heating.
 - Clean the door seal, cavity, and details of adjacent parts.
 - Door Seal Cleaning
Wipe the door seal with a cloth dipped in an alkaline detergent (use a small brush dipped in toothpaste to clean narrow crevices), then wipe clean with a damp cloth, and finally dry with a dry cloth.
 - It is recommended to clean the microwave oven regularly and remove all food residues.
 - Not cleaning the microwave oven can lead to the deterioration of the appliance's surface, affecting its lifespan, and may also result in dangerous situations.
 - This microwave oven can only use the temperature probe recommended for this microwave oven. (Based on actual product features)
 - For fixed and built-in appliances with removable turntables used at a height of

900mm or higher from the ground, the instructions should indicate that when removing containers from the appliance, care should be taken not to pull out the turntable.

- This requirement does not apply to appliances with horizontally hinged bottom doors. (Subject to actual product functions) Do not use the steam cleaner to clean appliances.
- The microwave oven is designed for built-in use or placement in a cabinet.
- The manufacturer should provide the minimum dimensions for the cabinet (refer to technical specifications and installation instructions), and the user manual should indicate that all cabinet doors should be open when the appliance is operating.
- The microwave oven is equipped with an additional decorative door, which should be open when the appliance is operating. (Subject to actual product functions)

⚠ Warning: When the appliance operates in combination mode, due to the high temperatures generated, children should use it under adult supervision.

- The appliance will heat up during use. Be careful to avoid contact with the heating elements inside the oven.

⚠ Warning: Some parts may become hot during use. Keep children away.

- Do not clean the glass on the oven door with abrasive cleaners or sharp metal scrapers, as this can scratch the glass surface and lead to breakage.

⚠ Warning: To avoid the risk of electric shock, ensure the appliance is disconnected from the power supply before replacing the light.

- The steam cleaner must not be used. Use only the temperature sensing probe recommended for this oven. (Refer to the actual product features)

⚠ Warning: After the appliance has been used, the heating element and cavity may still be hot. Avoid touching the inside of the cavity to prevent burns.

⚠ Warning: Only allow children to use the microwave oven unsupervised when they have been given adequate instruction to use it safely and understand that

improper use can be dangerous.

⚠ Warning: Parts that can be touched during use may become hot. Children should stay away, as some surfaces may be very hot while the appliance is operating. Surfaces marked with the "High Temperature Surface" symbol will become hot during use.

- Place out of reach of children
Children should only be allowed to use the product unsupervised after they have been given adequate instruction to use it safely and understand the dangers of improper use. When the appliance operates in combination mode, due to temperature increase, children must use it under adult supervision.

- High Temperature Surface, Prevent Burns
The middle inner side of the handle may become hot; the appliance is disconnected from power.

- Appliances for the oven should not be installed behind decorative doors to prevent overheating.

- Clean surfaces that come into contact with food

✖ Fats produced during cooking can corrode the oven cavity, affecting heating efficiency and altering the taste of food. Therefore, clean the oven cavity promptly after use;

✖ Regularly clean the metal baking tray, ceramic dish, and metal grate with warm water. Note: After prolonged cooking in the microwave oven, do not clean immediately with cold water. (These are cleaning instructions; for specific details, refer to the documentation provided with the unit)

- Baby bottles and baby food jars should be shaken or stirred, and the temperature of the food inside should be checked before feeding to avoid burns.
- It must not be operated with an external timer or an independent remote control system.

⚠ Warning Incorrect use can cause potential injuries:

✖ Do not insert metal objects or foreign objects, such as wires or fingers, into the product's air intake, vents, or louvers, as this may lead to electric

shock and injury. If a foreign object is accidentally inserted into the product, unplug the power plug and contact our repair service center;

- ※ Do not place the power cord or plug near vents, outer covers, areas with excessively high temperatures, or damp locations to prevent the power cord from deteriorating and causing hazards;
- ※ After use, be sure to promptly unplug the power plug and do not place it near a heat source or submerge it in water;
- ※ Do not place the power cord and plug directly on the outer cover to prevent residual heat from damaging the power cord;
- ※ Do not unplug the plug during cooking. Unplugging the plug can cause sparks, fires, electric shocks, etc;
- ※ Do not fry food. Do not use the product to fry food to prevent fires.

⚠ Warning: Do not remove the outer cover or attempt to modify the appliance, as it contains high-voltage power sources.

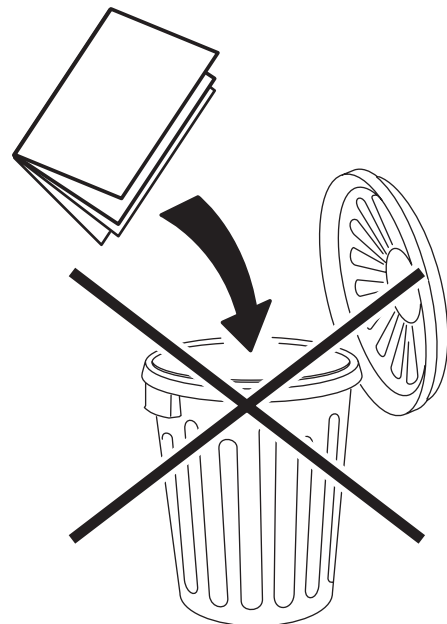
⚠ Warning: Only qualified service personnel should perform maintenance operations. If you encounter any issues during use, please contact our customer service center for repairs.

- Do not insert any foreign objects into the interlock switch of the oven door.
- When cleaning, if the control settings are higher than those used during normal cooking, the surface temperature may be higher than usual. Keep children away.
- Delayed Cooling(Refer to the actual product function)
After cooking, the fan will continue to run to cool down the appliance. You can open the door to remove food, and the fan will stop automatically once cooling is complete. This is a normal operation and requires no further action.
- Cooling during the cooking process (Subject to the actual product function)
During the cooking process or when paused, the fan will continue to operate, which is a normal phenomenon. You can continue to complete the cooking at this time.

- Overheating should be avoided
The biggest feature of microwave products is speed. After starting the product, you must frequently monitor the cooking situation inside the oven to avoid overheating.
- Overheating can cause smoke or fire, and overheated containers may melt or crack. When heating food packaged in plastic or paper, observe the microwave oven carefully, as there is a risk of fire. Heating small amounts of food for extended periods, due to the heat not being sufficiently absorbed by the food, can cause the oven cavity to become abnormally hot, leading to burns. Therefore, do not touch the oven cavity after use.

Electric Shock Hazard

Touching some of the internal components can cause serious personal injury or death. Do not disassemble this appliance.

⚠ WARNING!

Electric Shock Hazard

Improper use of the grounding can result in electric shock. Do not plug into an outlet until appliance is properly installed and grounded.

This appliance must be grounded. In the event of an electrical short circuit, grounding reduces the risk of electric shock by providing an escape wire for the electric current. This appliance is equipped with a cord having a grounding wire with a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an outlet that is properly installed and grounded.

Consult a qualified electrician or serviceman if the grounding instructions are not completely understood or if doubt exists as to whether the appliance is properly grounded. If it is necessary to use an extension cord, use only a 3-wire extension cord.

- A short power-supply cord is provided to reduce the risks resulting from becoming entangled in or tripping over a longer cord.
- If a long cord set or extension cord is used:
 - The marked electrical rating of the cord set or extension cord should be at least as great as the electrical rating of the appliance.
 - The extension cord must be a grounding-type 3-wire cord.
 - The long cord should be arranged so that it will not drape over the counter top or tabletop where it can be pulled on by children or tripped over unintentionally.

CLEANING

Be sure to unplug the appliance from the power supply.

- Clean the cavity of the oven after using with a slightly damp cloth.
- Clean the accessories in the usual way in soapy water.
- The door frame and seal and neighbouring parts must be cleaned carefully with a damp cloth when they are dirty.
- Do not use harsh abrasive cleaners or sharp metal scrapers to clean the oven door glass since they can scratch the surface, which may result in shattering of the glass.
- Cleaning Tip ★ For easier cleaning of the cavity walls that the food cooked can touch: Place half a lemon in a bowl, add 300ml (1/2 pint) water and heat on 100% microwave power for 10 minutes. Wipe the oven clean using a soft, dry cloth.

⚠ CAUTION

Personal Injury Hazard

It is hazardous for anyone other than a competent person to carry out any service or repair operation that involves the removal of a cover which gives protection against exposure to microwave energy.

See the instructions on **"MATERIALS YOU CAN USE IN MICROWAVE OVEN OR TO BE AVOIDED IN MICROWAVE OVEN."**

There may be certain non-metallic utensils that are not safe to use for microwaving. If in doubt, you can test the utensil in question following the procedure below.

Utensil Test:

- Fill a microwave-safe container with 1 cup of cold water (250ml) along with the utensil in question.
- Cook on maximum power for 1 minute.
- Carefully feel the utensil. If the empty utensil is warm, do not use it for microwave cooking.
- Do not exceed 1 minute cooking time.

Materials you can use in microwave oven

Utensils	Remarks
Browning dish	Follow manufacturer's instructions. The bottom of browning dish must be at least 3/16 inch (5 mm) above the turntable. Incorrect usage may cause the turntable to break.
Dinnerware	Microwave-safe only. Follow manufacturer's instructions. Do not use cracked or chipped dishes.
Glass jars	Always remove lid. Use only to heat food until just warm. Most glass jars are not heat resistant and may break.
Glassware	Heat-resistant oven glassware only. Make sure there is no metallic trim. Do not use cracked or chipped dishes.
Oven cooking bags	Follow manufacturer's instructions. Do not close with metal tie. Make slits to allow steam to escape.
Paper plates and cups	Use for short-term cooking/warming only. Do not leave oven unattended while cooking.
Paper towels	Use to cover food for reheating and absorbing fat. Use with supervision for a short-term cooking only.
Parchment paper	Use as a cover to prevent splattering or a wrap for steaming.
Plastic	Microwave-safe only. Follow the manufacturer's instructions. Should be labeled "Microwave Safe". Some plastic containers soften, as the food inside gets hot. "Boiling bags" and tightly closed plastic bags should be slit, pierced or vented as directed by package.
Plastic wrap	Microwave-safe only. Use to cover food during cooking to retain moisture. Do not allow plastic wrap to touch food.
Thermometers	Thermometers Microwave-safe only (meat and candy thermometers).
Wax paper	Use as a cover to prevent splattering and retain moisture.

Materials to be avoided in microwave oven

Utensils	Remarks
Aluminum tray	May cause arcing. Transfer food into microwave-safe dish.
Food carton with metal handle	May cause arcing. Transfer food into microwave-safe dish.
Metal or metaltrimmed utensils	Metal shields the food from microwave energy. Metal trim may cause arcing.
Metal twist ties	May cause arcing and could cause a fire in the oven.
Paper bags	May cause a fire in the oven.
Plastic foam	Plastic foam may melt or contaminate the liquid inside when exposed
Wood	Wood will dry out when used in the microwave oven and may split or crack.

Safety Precautions

⚠ Caution

- After cooking is complete, the system fan will continue to operate to facilitate cooling, which is a normal phenomenon.



Prohibit Microwave Operation Without Load

Do not start the machine without placing food inside to avoid the oven becoming abnormally hot, which may cause malfunction



Overheat Protection

Continuous use should not be excessively long to prevent the machine from entering an overheating protection state, which will stop the heating process.

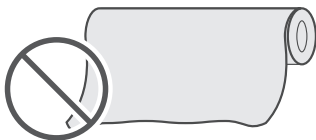

Socket Safety

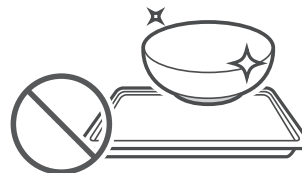

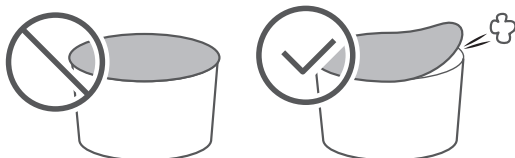
Do not heat foods in their shells

- When heating sealed foods, leave an opening, or they might explode!

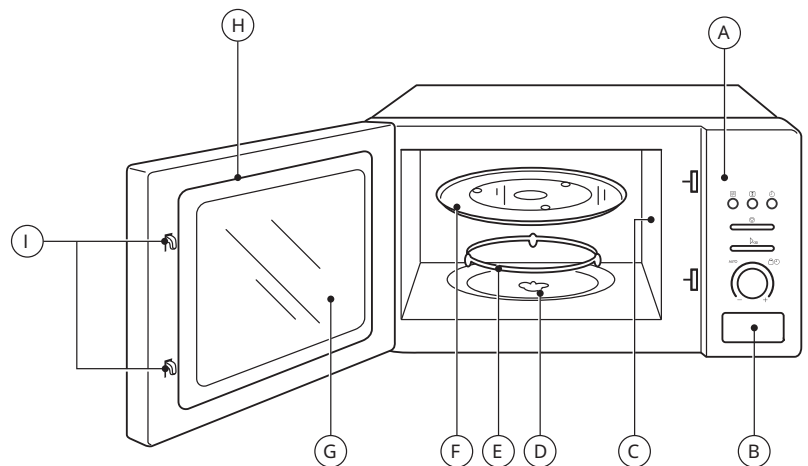

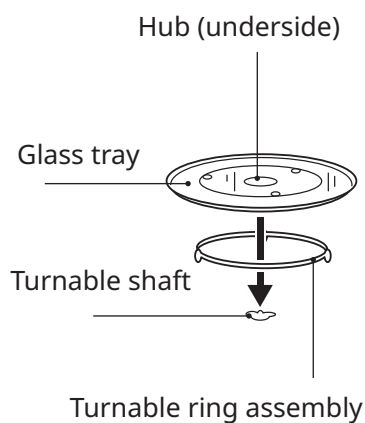

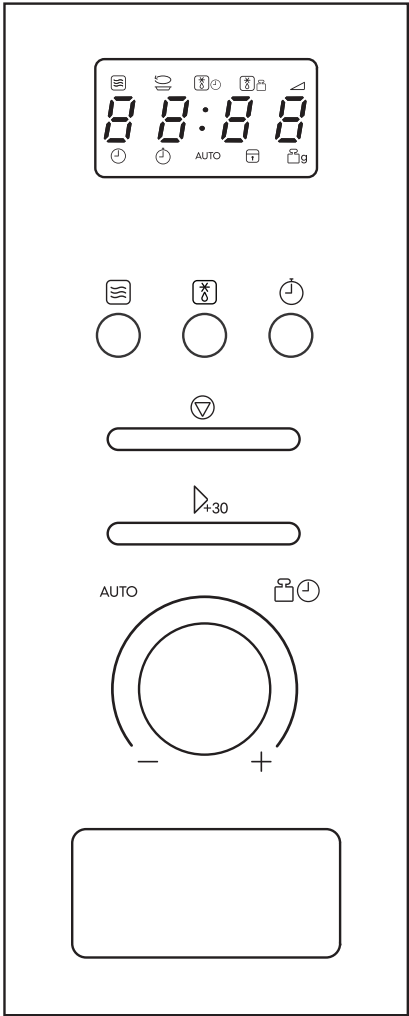
- A) Control panel

Turntable installation



- a) Never place the glass tray upside down. The glass tray should never be restricted.
- b) Both glass tray and turntable ring assembly must always be used during cooking.
- c) All food and containers of food are always placed on the glass tray for cooking.
- d) If glass tray or turntable ring assembly cracks or breaks, contact your nearest authorized service center.
- e) Never put frozen food directly on a warm turntable.

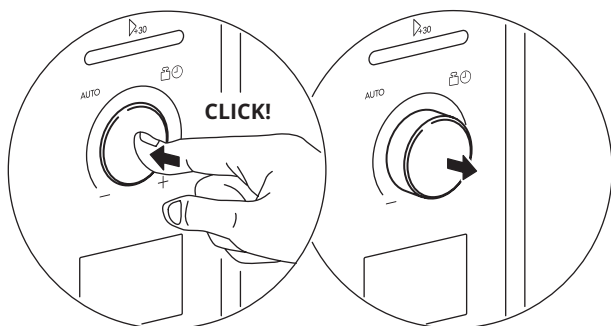

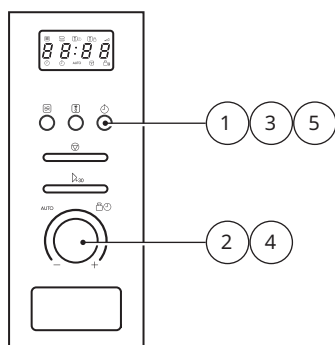
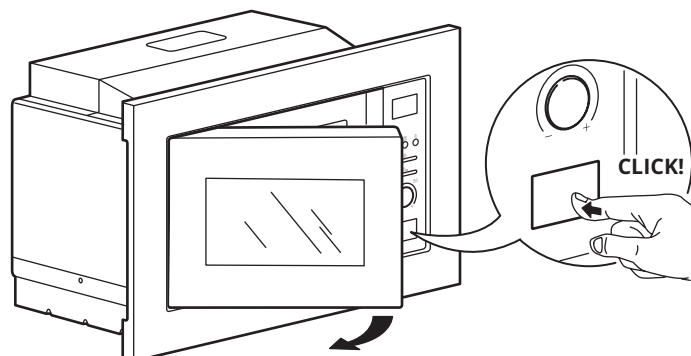
Using the knob

To use the selection knob, push it inwards and it will pop out.



Open the door

Push the button to open the door.



Clock setting

When the microwave oven is electrified, the screen will display "0:00", buzzer will ring once.

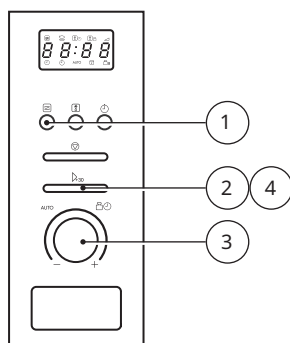
1. Press **Kitchen timer/Clock** twice to select clock function, the hour figures will flash.
2. Turn knob to adjust the hour figures, the input time should be within 0--23.
3. Press **Kitchen timer/Clock**, the minute figures will flash, the hour figures will light.
4. Turn knob to adjust the minute figures, the input time should be within 0--59.
5. Press **Kitchen timer/Clock** to finish clock setting, : will flash.

Note: During the process of clock setting, if you do not press **Kitchen timer/Clock** to confirm in 1 minute, the oven will go back to previous status automatically.

Lock-out function for children

Lock: In waiting state, press **Stop/Clear** for 3 seconds, there will be a long "beep" denoting entering the children-lock state and screen will display [] or current time.

Lock quitting: In locked state, press **Stop/Clear** for 3 seconds, there will be a long "beep" denoting that the lock is released.

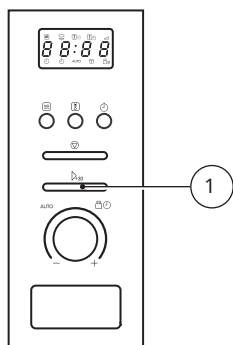
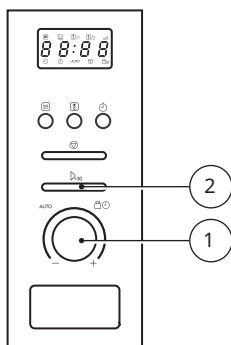


Microwave cooking

1. Press **Microwave** once, the screen will display 80 flickering. Press **Microwave** repeatedly or turn the knob to choose the power you want.
2. Then press **Start/+30 Sec** to confirm selected power level.
3. Turn knob to set cooking time from 0:05 to 95:00.
4. Press **Start/+30 Sec** again to start cooking.

Note: The time steps for the time when turning the knob are as follow:

0---1 min	: 5 seconds
1---5 min	: 10 seconds
5---10 min	: 30 seconds
10---30 min	: 1 minute
30---95 min	: 5 minutes

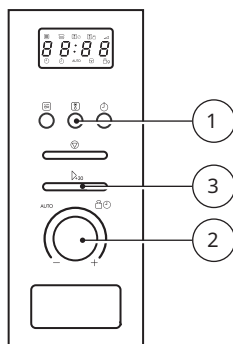
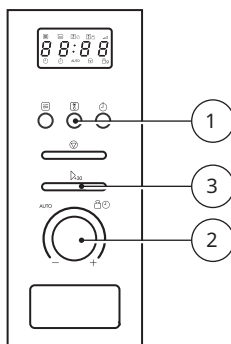

1. In stand by mode, press **Start/+30 Sec** to start cooking with full power for 30 seconds, each added press will increase 30 seconds cooking time up to 95 minutes.

Quick start alternative 2

1. In stand by mode, turn the knob to the right to set the time.
2. Press **Start/+30 Sec** to start cooking at full microwave power.

Note: In microwave or time defrost state, each press of **Start/+30 Sec** can increase 30 seconds of cooking time.

Defrost by weight**Defrost by time****Defrost by weight**

1. Press **Weight/Time Defrost** once, and the oven will display **def1**.
2. Turn the knob to select the weight of food from 100 to 2000g.
3. Press **Start/+30 Sec** to start defrosting.

Defrost by time

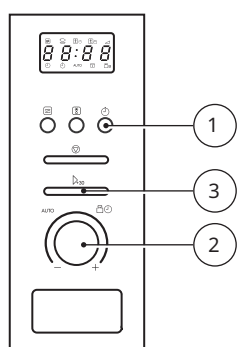
1. Press **Weight/Time Defrost** twice, and the oven will display **def2**.
2. Turn the knob to select the defrost time. The MAX. time is 95 minutes.
3. Press **Start/+30 Sec** to start defrosting.

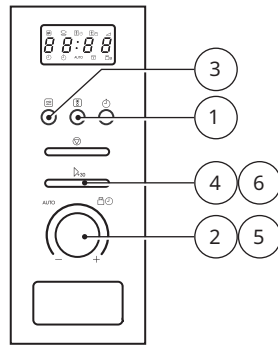
The product will prompt you to turn the food after half of the time set for defrosting. Open the door and turn the food, shut the door and press **Start/+30 Sec** to continue the defrosting.

Kitchen timer

1. Press **Kitchen timer/Clock** once, screen will display **00:00**, clock indicator will light.
2. Turn the knob to enter the correct time. (Maximum time to set is 95 minutes.)
3. Press **Start/+30 Sec** to confirm setting, clock indicator will be flickering.

When the kitchen time is reached, clock indicator will go out and the buzzer will ring 5 times.



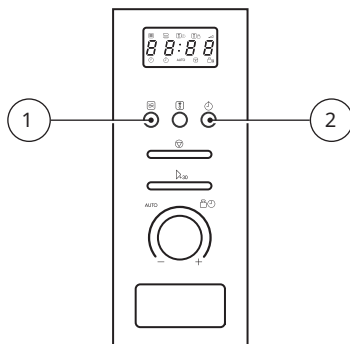


The product can be set to perform a multi stage cooking, defrosting followed by reheating:

Multi-section cooking

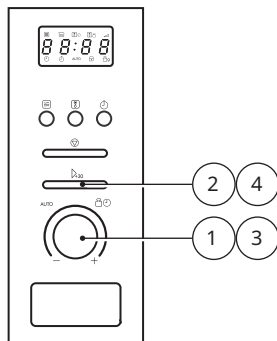
1. Press **Weight/Time Defrost** twice, and the oven will display **def2**.
2. Turn the knob to select the defrost time.
3. Press **Microwave** once, the screen will display **80**, repeatedly push the button or turn the knob to set the requested microwave power.
4. Press **Start/+30 Sec** to confirm power setting.
5. Turn the knob to select cooking time.
6. Press **Start/+30 Sec** to start cooking.

The product will prompt you to turn the food after half of the time set for defrosting. Open the door and turn the food, shut the door and press **Start/+30 Sec** to continue the defrosting. The buzzer will sound once again entering the second cooking. When cooking finishes, buzzer sound five times.



Inquiring function

1. In state of microwave cooking, press **Microwave**, the current power will be displayed for 3 seconds.
2. In cooking state, press **Kitchen timer/Clock** to inquire the time of the day, the time will be displayed for 3 seconds.



Auto menu

1. Turn the knob "A" left to choose the menu, and **A-1** to **A-8** will display.
2. Press **Start/+30 Sec** to confirm selected food.
3. Turn the knob "A" to choose the default weight as the menu chart.
4. Press **Start/+30 Sec** to start cooking.

Trouble shooting

Normal	
Microwave oven interfering TV reception	Radio and TV reception may be interfered when microwave oven operating. It is similar to the interference of small electrical appliances, like mixer, vacuum cleaner, electric fan. It is normal.
Dim oven light	In low power microwave cooking, oven light may become dim. It is normal.
Steam accumulating on door, hot air out of vents.	In cooking, steam may come out of food. Most will get out from vents, but some may accumulate on cool place like oven door. It is normal.
Oven started accidentally with no food in.	<i>It is forbidden to run the unit without any food inside. It is very dangerous.</i>

Trouble	Possible cause	Remedy
Oven can not be started.	(1) Power cord not plugged tightly.	Unplug the cord. Wait 10 seconds and plug it again.
	(2) Fuse blowing or circuit breaker works.	Replace fuse or reset circuit breaker (repaired by professional personnel of our company)
	(3) Trouble with outlet.	Test outlet with other electrical appliances.
Oven does not heat	(4) Door not closed well.	Close door well.

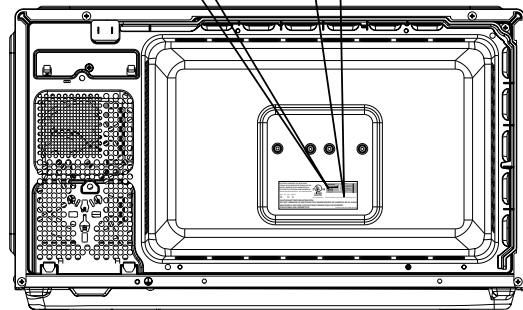

Installation and connection

1. This appliance is only intended for domestic use.
2. This oven is intended for built-in use only. It is not intended for counter-top use or for use inside a cupboard.
3. Please observe the special installation instructions.
4. The appliance can be installed in a 60cm wide wall-mounted cupboard.
5. The appliance is fitted with a plug and must only be connected to a properly installed earthed socket.
6. The mains voltage must correspond to the voltage specified on the rating plate.
7. The socket must be installed and connecting cable must only be replaced by a qualified electrician. If the plug is no longer to accessible following

installation, an all-pole disconnecting device must be present on the installation side with a contact gap of at least 3mm.

8. Adapters, multi-way strips and extension leads must not be used. Overloading can result in a risk of fire.
9. The product should not be mounted below 85cm.



The accessible surface maybe hot during operation.
